Thank you for your interest in joining our association. As an Association of International Baccalaureate® World Schools, IB Schools Australasia has been formerly recognised by the IB and we work closely with the IB to advocate on behalf of our member schools. Associations can be an indispensable resource for both those schools new to the IB as well as those well-established schools.

**All Authorized, Candidate and Partner schools in Australia, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea and Fiji are eligible to join IB Schools Australasia.**

### The history of IB Schools Australasia

The Association of Australasian IB Schools was established in the late 1980s when the International Baccalaureate® was relatively new to Australasia. The aim of the association when it began was to support Australasian schools in delivering the International Baccalaureate® Programmes and to provide a network of professional support, information and service.

Through 2016 AAIBS underwent a re-branding and are now known as IB Schools Australasia.

Today the association remains committed to the original purpose. Its goals are:

- To promote the IB programs and support IB schools within Australasia
- To provide professional support for teachers and schools in areas not covered by the IB
- To liaise with the IBAP Regional Office in matters affecting the interest of IB Schools in Australasia
- To support the IB in promoting its programs in the Australasian region
- To advocate for IB programs with government and educational agencies/organisations in Australasia

### Benefits of Membership

During the past three years, the association has gone through an intensive process of evaluation and reflection to ensure we are providing our member schools with the services they require. Our services are outlined below:

- **Access to Professional Learning, specifically designed for our Member Schools:** Speaker Series and in-house MELT workshops
- **Employment Services:** Free of charge advertisement of school positions through our website (new in 2018) and on social media
- **School Promotion Opportunities:** Listing on our website and Social Media promotion
- **Access to courses for students:** PYP Student Speaker Series (New in 2018) and MYP Student Speaker Series

- **IB Schools Australasia Certificates for Students and Awards Booklet Template:** Our Certificates for PYP, MYP and DP students can be used for in school and state based awards ceremonies. In 2017, we introduced an Awards booklet template that could be used for Network awards ceremonies to recognise student achievements.

### Visiting Speaker Series

The Association is a recognised provider of professional development by the IB. We provide professional learning activities to enable member schools to participate in with an affordable fee and minimum travel costs.

In 2018 IB Schools Australasia will host the fourth Annual Speaker Series as a commitment to the professional support of staff of member schools. The Visiting Speaker Series is designed to bring to the member schools and wider community with an interest in the IB, presentations which inform, challenge and inspire participants. These will also be designed to promote the IB and the ideals of the programs.

The Visiting Speaker Series brings the expertise and experience of Dr John Willison for broad-reaching conversations that motivate and educate.

The theme of this series will be *Models of Engaged Learning and Teaching for amplifying approaches to learning, PYP through to DP*.

### Employment Services

IB Schools Australasia recognises that our Member Schools are employers of choice, therefore to assist schools with sourcing the best candidates for positions, IB Schools Australasia provides advertising on our website at <https://ibaustralasia.org/careers> in our Newsletter, Facebook page and LinkedIn page free of charge. All financial member schools are entitled to list as many positions as required to support their IB programme/s.

### School promotion opportunities on the website

IB Schools Australasia provides a web presence for member schools at [www.ibaustralasia.org](http://www.ibaustralasia.org) and will extend this to local associations of member schools as part of the annual membership fee. Member schools should ensure their details on this site are up to date.

The website provides members schools with the opportunity to maintain an IB Schools Australasia member profile page with an IB Schools Australasia profile URL (<https://ibaustralasia.org/schools>). This feature has two significant benefits for member schools:

- The SEO - Search Engine Optimisation (*the process of affecting the visibility of your School's website in a search engine's organic (unpaid) search results.*) is enhanced
- The Domain/Page Authority (*the measure of the power of your school's website domain name in terms of search engine rankings*) is enhanced.

### Certificates for Students

IB Schools Australasia provides to members, free of charge, certificates that can be presented at various ceremonies at a state and individual school level

#### Diploma Programme

- *Certificate of Distinction* for DP graduates who have achieved an IB score of 40 points or more.
- *Certificate of Merit* for DP graduates who have achieved at least one Grade 7 in one subject or an 'A' in Extended Essay /Theory of Knowledge.
- *Certificate of outstanding Creativity, Action and Service*. This Certificate is to be presented within schools as they see fit for a small number of students whose CAS embodies the IB mission statement ideal. It is anticipated that there would be only one of two of these awarded in any one school.
- *Diploma Achievement*. This Certificate is for DP graduates who have completed the requirements of the Diploma. This certificate could be used by schools or Networks that have ceremonies where all students who pass the Diploma are recognised.

#### Middle Years Programme

- *Certificate of Distinction* are for students who have achieved an overall average score greater than 6 across all subjects
- *Certificate of Merit* for students who have achieved a score of 7 in one or more subjects.
- *Certificate of outstanding Service in Action*. This certificate is to be presented within schools as they see fit to a small number of students whose Service embodies the IB mission statement ideal. It is anticipated that there would be only one or two of these awarded in any one school.
- *Certificate of Participation*. This Certificate is for students who have participated in the Middle Years Programme and been involved in the Personal Project and is awarded on the completion of the programme.

#### Primary Years Programme

- *Certificate of Participation* for students who have participated in the Primary Years Programme and have been involved in the Exhibition in the final year.

### Working with IB Networks in Australasia

The IB Schools Australasia Standing Committee is committed, amongst other goals, to represent and support the various IB groups and networks across Australasia. It is important that these networks have a united voice in lobbying with Educational Authorities, Tertiary Admissions Centres, Universities and the IB. IB Schools Australasia wants to support and work with these IB school networks.

#### Annual Membership Fees

The Annual membership fees are GST exempt and are as follows:

- Full Membership for *Authorised* schools is \$500.00AUD
- Associate Membership for recognised *Candidate* schools is \$200.00AUD
- Partner Membership \$150.00AUD

Please note if you have multiple campuses and/or multiple IB programmes run at your school you are only required to pay the membership fee once for the highest authorization status received.
